Falls Park in Pendleton was known as "The Falls" back in 1820. At that time, there were more than a hundred settlers here. The town name, Pendleton, came from a settler, Thomas Pendleton, who owned several acres of land just south of "The Falls".

In the time period ranging from the 1820s to the 1850s Pendleton acquired many firsts. For instance, the first court held was at Thomas Pendleton's cabin. Back then, the judges who presided there were required to take an oath to abstain from dueling. Pendleton's first public school in the county was established in 1823 and the privilege of teaching was put up at a public sale - the lowest bidder to be teacher (and he had to furnish his own wood)! the first store was located at the corner of Main and State where this original building is still in use. The first church was built and dedicated as the Pendleton Methodist Episcopal Church by its members. The first train in the county was put into operation between Indianapolis and Pendleton in 1850. A quarry which supplies limestone was opened near "The Falls". This quarry is now filled with water and forms a beautiful lake in the present Falls Park.
